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Review:

The title reflects the content properly and the topic will be of interest to the readers of the journal. Simply put, the paper bears an explicit orientation towards the aim of iJET. The purpose, design, and nature of the study are well expressed in the abstract. The introduction provides a good background of the topic that quickly gives the reader an appreciation of the wide range of applications for the TPACK. It gives a clear overview and organization of the article. Moreover, sufficient information about the previous study findings is presented for readers to follow the present study rationale and procedures.

The methods are generally appropriate and there is good balance between the presentation of data and analysis. The results respond to the purpose of the study and the findings are discussed with a reference to relevant and recent literature. The conclusion highlights the importance of four TPACK domains of ESP teachers that found in this study. It is highly acceptable and it focus on the empirical findings of the stated research methodology. However, new information is included and there is no mention of directions for further researches. In addition, implications for future research may also be included in the conclusion at the end. Overall, this is a high quality manuscript that has implications for the theoretical basis and development of TPACK of ESP teachers in a blended learning.


