What is report text?

Report text is a text that presents information about something, as it as. It is as a result of systematic observation and analysis especially done and conducted by researchers or scientists. The information given in a report text is very general infromation.

What is Social function of report text?

To present information about something generally. It generally describes the way things are with reference to natural, manmade and social phenomena in our environment.



Generic Structure of Report Text

- General Classification

- Description

This part gives a description of the things which will be discussed in more detail, in terms of: parts (and their functions), qualities, habits, and behavior.

Example of Report Text



General Classification

A kangaroo is an animal found only in Australia, although it has a smaller relative, called a wallaby, which lives on the Australian island of Tasmania and also in New Guinea.

Description

Kangaroos usually eat grass and plants. They have short front legs, but very long and very strong back legs and a tail. These are used for sitting up and for jumping. Kangaroos have been known to make forward jumps of over eight meters, and leap across fences more than three meters high. They can also run at speeds of over 45 kilometers per hour.

The largest kangaroos are the Great Grey Kangaroo and the Red Kangaroo. Adult grow to a length of 1.60 meters and weigh over 90 kilos.

Kangaroos are marsupials. This means that the female kangaroo has an external pouch on the front of her body. A baby kangaroo is very tiny when it is born, and it crawls at once into this pouch where it spends its first five months of life.

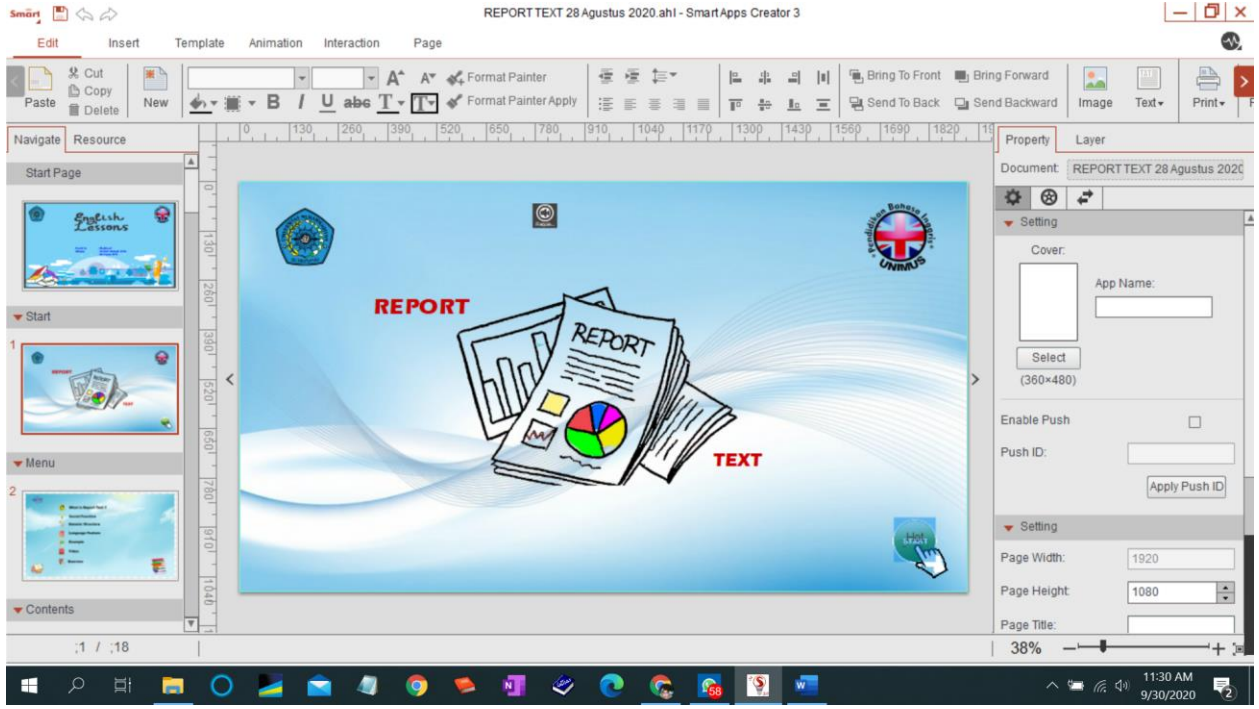
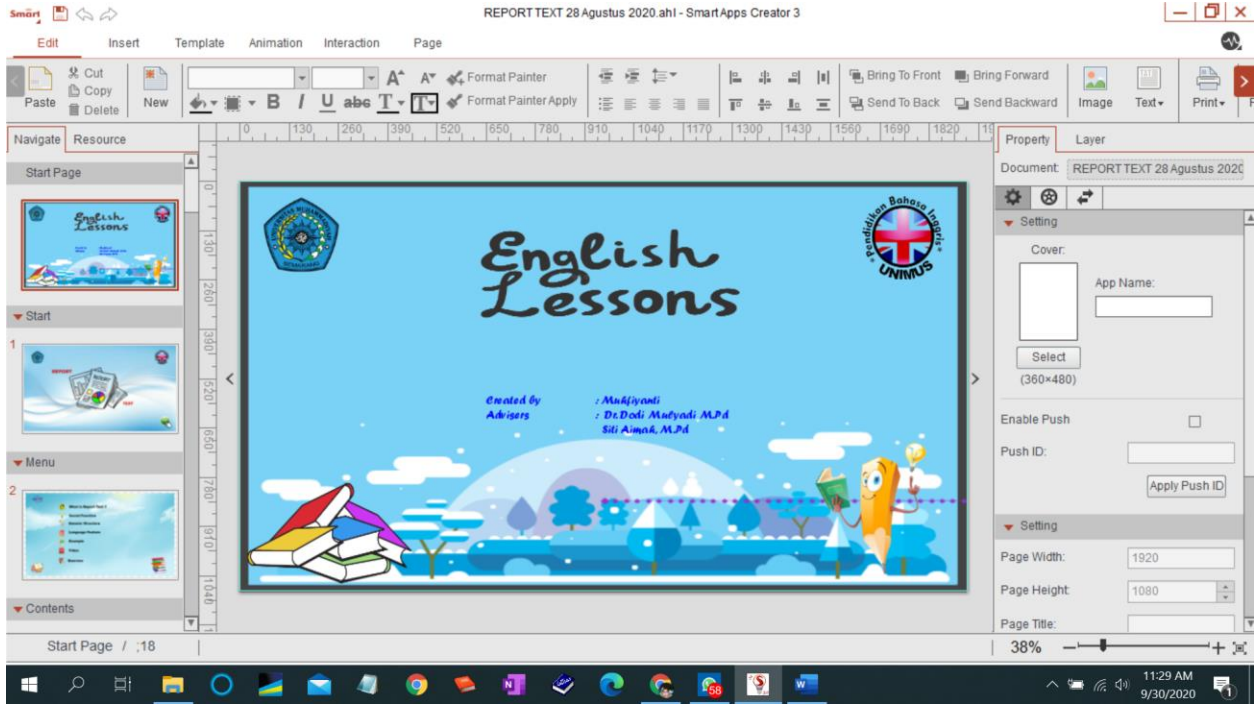

General Classification → A kangaroo is an animal found only in Australia, although it has a smaller relative, called a wallaby, which lives on the Australian island of Tasmania and also in New Guinea.

Description → Kangaroos usually eat grass and plants. They have short front legs, but very long and very strong back legs and a tail. These are used for sitting up and for jumping. Kangaroos have been known to make forward jumps of over eight meters, and leap across fences more than three meters high. They can also run at speeds of over 45 kilometers per hour.
