Reviewer 1 report:

Comments to authors

- 1-Although there is an age difference between the patient group included in the study and the control group, can we state that miR29b level is negatively correlated with age?
- 2-Although miR29b level has been shown to be associated with cancer, neurogenerative diseases and many systemic diseases, are the inclusion criteria specified for the patients included in this study sufficient?
- 3-There is no data on the glycemic control parameters of the patients included in the study. Information about this data should be added.
- 4-No information was shared about the diabetes duration of the patients and the treatments they were receiving. 5-Information on the status of microvascular complications in diabetic patients was not provided. Does this affect miR-29b expression?
- 6-How can you explain the negative correlation with fasting plasma glucose, although it is stated in the article that there is miR-29b overexpression in diabetic patients?
- 7-In this article, there is no data on the patients' habits, such as cigarette smoking and alcohol use, that may affect oxidative stress and miR-29b levels.

Reviewer 2 report: Comments to authors

Introduction:

- 1- What do the authors try to mean in the very first sentence: "In Indonesia, non-communicable diseases such as stroke, hypertension, diabetes mellitus, tumor, and heart disease continually increased, but this has not been accompanied by a decrease in the number of infectious diseases."; should a decrease in the infectious disorders expected while the other disorders mentioned increase?
- 2- Can the author provide reference(s) for this sentence? "Micro-RNA has importance to increase Reactive Oxygen Species (ROS) or decrease the antioxidant expression in T2DM" Discussion:

This sentence in the discussion section "The miR-29b level is correlated with fasting blood glucose. The higher the expression of miR-29b, the fasting blood glucose level will decrease." Contradicts with the authors' results on the expression of miR-29b in T2DM cases. In the results section the authors show a 14.12 fold increase of miR-29b in T2DM cases, while in the discussion they say the high miR-29b is associated with low FBG levels. Looking at Table 1 this statement is highly contradictive. Can the authors clarify this issue.

Also the discussion is too elaborate and lengthy. miR-29b is highly popular and well studied miRNA, however the authors need to sum up findings of the literature in line with their aims and findings of their studies.

There are plenty of grammar errors, so language editing is needed.




